The above table reflects the reasons associated with a family who is referred for FPS as an initial service decisions during the fiscal year. A CINC report is assigned for reasons of either alleged abuse/ neglect or non abuse neglect. The data source of information in this table is KIDS (Kansas Initiative for Decision Support). KIDS has the capacity to record more than one allegation or presenting situation for each assigned report. The presenting situations listed above may not reflect all risk factors associated with a family. Reasons collapsed into the "Other" category include overwhelmed parent, runaway and parent child conflict (non abuse/ neglect categories).
