Strategic Plan TX Panel: Improving & Strengthening the Treatment System

Design for Consumer Centered Recovery Services

Team Focus:

Service Delivery System for Detox/Multiple Admissions

Charter Process:

The teams are designed for a specific task and over a specific time frame. Teams will not be established for a period of greater than three months, unless reviewed and continued need is determined.

Team Purpose:

To recommend (a) standardized protocols for detox and multiple admissions (3 or more; (b) to identify program performance measures; and (c) core competencies for detox staff to ensure customer accessibility engagement, and retention.

Boundaries/Expectations:

- Work within existing resources as much as possible.
- Maintain the NIDA Principles in the design process.
- Use practices supported by research.
- Assess impact of proposed changes not only to those closely tied to the treatment system but to the system's partners.
- Identify relevant resources of data that are supportive of the Teams recommendations to the Oversight Committee.

Accountability/Reporting Structure:

Report to the System Redesign Oversight Committee

- When you need clarity in order to complete the work.
- When you are ready to present your recommendation
